


Primary Tooth Development

| Second molar | 25-33 mos. | 10-12 yrs. |
| Lower Teeth | Erupt | Shed |
| Second molar | 23-31 mos. | 10-12 yrs. |
| First molar | 14-18 mos. | 9-11 yrs. |
| Canine (cuspid) | 17-23 mos. | 9-12 yrs. |
| Lateral incisor | 10-16 mos. | 7-8 yrs. |
| Central incisor | 6-10 mos. | 6-7 yrs. |
